



Guided snowshoe-tours in Schwanden

4 hours / 9 km / ↑ 480 m / ↓ 480 m



Above the magnificent area of Lake Thun the winter hiking trail of Schwanden offers a beautiful view to the mountains in the Bernese Oberland. A quiet fir forest and wide snowscape are dominating the scenery. The panorama view is splendid: In the center you will see the two spectacular mountains Niesen and Stockhorn. This combined with a traditional outdoor fondue (if the weather is bad, we enjoy the raclette in the Landgasthof Rothorn) is perfect for a wonderful winter hiking day.

On this tour we look at the correct walking technique, observe animals and identify their tracks, discuss how to behave properly in nature in winter and do exercises together so that you get to know the snow layers better. After the hike you will receive the brochure "Wild animal-friendly in nature" which will accompany you throughout the winter so that you can see more animal tracks in the snow!

Details to the snowshoe-tour:

- **Dates:** 17. December 2022, 8. January und 26. February 2023 or every Wednesday (until 11. January 2023)
- **Time:** 11am to 7pm
- **Start/end:** Meeting point: Bus stop Schwanden Säge
- **Route:** Schwanden Säge - Twingi - Züsenegggrabe - Dünzenegg - Oberer Matte - Schonegg - Schwanden Säge
- **Time:** 7 hours, hiking time about 4 hours
- **Elevation difference:** about 480 m up and 480 m down
- **Kilometers:** about 9 km
- **Level of difficulty:** medium
- **Highlights:** Panorama mountains of the Bernese Oberland, relaxing outdoor experience, quietness, traditional outdoor fondue or raclette
- **Price:** adults CHF 110.- / children CHF 50.- (8-17 years), with raclette CHF 130.- / children CHF 60.- / including guide and raclette or fondue / Drinks and other expenses are not included. Group rates on request, rent of snow shoes (incl. sticks) CHF 30.- per person
- **Number of participants:** min. 5, max. 12 persons
